Dr. Scott H. Irwin, the Laurence J. Norton Chair of Agricultural Marketing at the University of Illinois, is a globally recognized thought leader in agricultural economics. He has written two books, most notably *Back to the Futures*, a fun and entertaining introduction to the world of commodity futures markets. Dr. Irwin also helped pioneer the *farmdoc* project, an innovative agricultural extension program that has been dubbed the "*Wall Street Journal* of ag business."

Dr. Irwin is a Fellow of the Agricultural and Applied Economics Association, the highest honor accorded to members. He continues to teach courses on commodity price analysis, fueled by a lifelong passion for commodity markets.
